The Northville Downtown Development Authority, DDA, comprehensively manages downtown to maximize our local economy. The DDA helps fund significant projects and on-going economic development activities to improve the quality of life, retain residents, attract talent and encourage and support private reinvestment, including:

- Analysis of economic issues taking place in the downtown district;
- Long range planning; land acquisition and improvement;
- Infrastructure and building construction, improvement, rehabilitation, maintenance and operation;
- Design, construction and maintenance of public facilities such as sidewalks, parking lots, streets, street lighting and parks.
- Revitalization of vacant and underutilized properties;
- Rehabilitation of historic buildings, assets and facades;
- Business recruitment and retention;
- Safety, security and maintenance programs; and
- Marketing and promotions
- Production of cultural programming, including more than 45 concerts and special events annually

The purpose of the DDA is to coordinate and support activities to promote the economic viability of the downtown area, acting as an advocate for a safe, clean and attractive central business district. A strong downtown center is a major attraction for development and enhances the quality of the life for the entire community.
